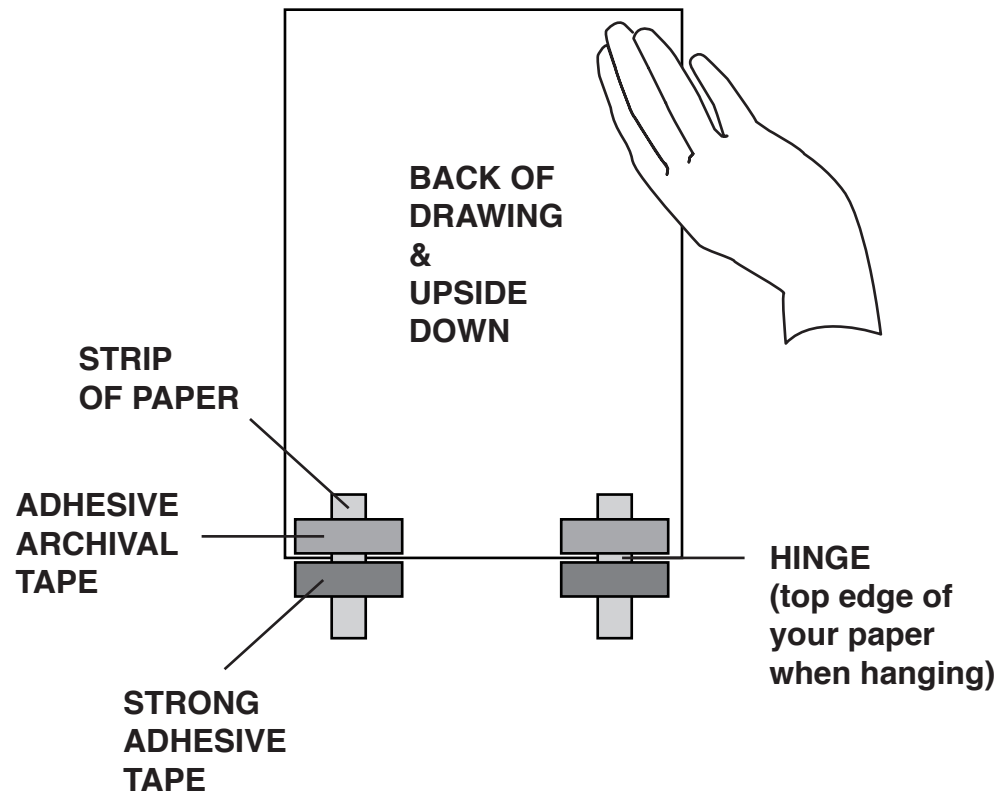


LW PAPER HINGES HANGING SYSTEM



A

Attach the strip of paper* to the top edge of the back of your paper with adhesive archival tape**.

Important: place the tape as close as possible to the edge of your paper.

B

Place the paper on the wall, back to front and upside down, so that the strips of paper are facing down on the wall.

C

Use strong adhesive tape to attach the paper strips to the wall.

Important: make sure you place the tape as close as possible to the edge of your paper. Press the tape on using your nails or folding bone or plastic handle of your scissors.

D

Gently let the paper fold over. Voilà!

*you can use any paper, but ideally, use paper that is 'weaker' than the paper of your work, so that the hinges would tear before tearing your work. You can fold the paper strip in half before attaching it, so that the hinge is clearly defined.

When the environment is very warm, the strong adhesive tape attached to the wall can weaken, always check temperature conditions.

**you can put a strip of archival tape on the paper edge before taping on the paper strips, that way you can just peel off the second layer tape and remove the paper strips.
